



## Space Use Information

Cedar Park is a very active church that shares space with a wide variety of community groups. Our building is wheelchair, walker and baby stroller accessible and has plenty of parking. It's easy to find, just off Highway 20 and boul. St. Jean, and is close to two bus routes.

To further our reputation as a community hub, we welcome inquiries about space use. In fairness to all, we apply space use fees because there are costs to operating our building, not the least of which are heat, lights and cleaning services.

Here are the various venues we may be able to offer:

### Sanctuary

The sanctuary is available for concerts, recitals, speakers and presentations. Seating capacity in the pews is 250 to 300.



## Kitchen

Our bright fully equipped kitchen has 2 ranges, plenty of counter space and a fast commercial dishwasher. Our kitchen is used for Meals on Wheels and various church programmes and activities and is a great place for cooking classes, batch cooking groups and baking clubs.



## Meeting Room

The Meeting Room is adjacent to the kitchen, close to two wheelchair-friendly restrooms. At 18 feet by 21 feet, its seating capacity is 35 people. Possible uses: meetings, training, discussion groups, crafting, home business product demos, etc.



## Annex

The Annex on the lower level works well for small groups and meetings. It has been used for a craft co-op, a small playgroup, training, support groups, book clubs, and a drumming circle. This space is 14 feet by 12 feet and has a kitchen and bathroom. Two sets of stairs are involved to access this space.



## Community Hall

The capacity of our newly renovated Community Hall is 140 people, seated. For events such as book launches, art shows and receptions, the standing room capacity is 230 people. References may be requested and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the premises.

We have 18 long tables, 24 card tables, 5 small round tables, 16 arm chairs and over 100 folding chairs available for use.

For an additional fee, we offer access to our stage with its original wood floor from 1954—perfect for dance recitals! The stage is 18 feet wide and 10 feet deep. The apron has 2 sets of stairs and extends 10 feet in front of the fully operational curtain. There's limited space in the wings due to our storage needs.





### Children's Birthday Parties

Special rates are offered for kids' parties, using the Meeting Room and kitchen for 3 hours and the Community Hall for an hour of playtime.
